PRESENTAZIONE DEL webinar

This talk will explore the connection between childhood wounds and adult love, with a special focus on how disorganized attachment affects later intimate relationships. Atlas will introduce The Frightened Child—a child who learned early that the people she loves and is dependent on can hurt her. Later in life, one of the main characteristics of the frightened child is the simultaneous wish for and fear of being close. The clinical case will discuss toxic nourishment, survival modes, safety, risk, and future struggles with intimacy.

Atlas serves on the editorial boards of Psychoanalytic Dialogues and Psychoanalytic Perspectives. She is a recipient of the NADTA Research Award, the Gradiva Award, and the Nautilus Book Award. Her next book, Come Closer: Childhood Wounds, Adult Love and the Secrets of Emotional Intimacy, will be published in fall 2026.
