RAZIONALE

Antimicrobial resistance and the increasing complexity of infectious diseases represent major challenges for modern healthcare, requiring coordinated and multidisciplinary approaches. This congress aims to translate innovation into clinical practice by addressing the appropriate use of new antibiotics, advances in rapid microbiological diagnostics, precision dosing strategies, and the implementation of effective antimicrobial stewardship programs.
